From the first pencil sketches, Brian Kane's design seemed to break the rules. He brought together the graceful curves of contoured seating and a structured grid framework, creating a combination of comfort and strength called Washington Square.

Washington Square supports the sitter in a more reclined position, which makes for more comfortable longer-term seating. So whether people are waiting or working, its unique design assures indoor comfort without sacrificing outdoor durability.

Intermediate Arms

2- and 3-seat units can be specified with intermediate arms for more defined and private seating.

Litter Receptacles

To complete the system, side- and top- opening receptacles are offered in coordinating perforated metal. They feature a hinged door for easy access to the 30-gallon polyethylene liner. Also available is an optional ash urn, and a keyed lock for additional security.

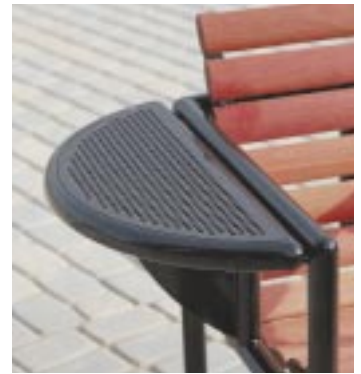
The side-opening receptacle with ash urn attachment provides protection from the elements for outdoor applications.

Wood Seat Choices

Wood seats feature shaped boards fastened to an internal metal strap, which is in turn bolted to the frame. Several exterior and interior wood choices are available.

Perforated Seats

Perforated metal seats are securely welded to the frame and all metal parts are finished with Landscape Forms' exclusive Pangard II® polyester powdercoat.

Tablet arm

The tablet arm provides a place for a mug, writing tablet, or laptop computer. The perforated metal coordinates with interior or exterior seating options.

Litter Receptacles

The top-opening receptacle is available in perforated metal, with a hinged door and a 30-gallon polyethylene liner. It is also available with an optional keyed lock or ash urn.

Tablet arm

The tablet arm provides a place for a mug, writing tablet, or laptop computer. The perforated metal coordinates with interior or exterior seating options.

Seats

Washington Square™ seats may be specified as one-, two-, or three-seat units. Frames are formed of 1-1/2" diameter steel tubing. Seats are available in perforated metal or a selection of interior and exterior woods. Wood seats are bolted to the frame. Perforated metal seats, formed of 11-gauge steel, are welded to the frames.

Arm Options

A tablet arm may be specified on one or both ends of one-, two-, or three-seat units. Intermediate arms may be specified for two- or three-seat units. Tablet arm frames are cast aluminum, insert panel is perforated aluminum, welded to frame. Intermediate arms are formed of 1-1/2" diameter steel tubing.

Side Table

Frame is 1-1/2" diameter steel tubing. Perforated metal panel is formed of 11-gauge steel.

Litter Receptacle

Constructed of perforated 11-gauge steel side panels, welded to 1-1/4" steel tube frame. Features a hinged door that swings open allowing the liner to slide out for emptying. The door latches when closed, a toe trip mechanism opens the door. An optional keyed lock may be specified. Polyethylene liner capacity is 30 gallons.

Ash Urn

The ash urn is formed of recycled aluminum and may be specified with either receptacle style. The ash urn hooks onto the top of the door.

- 1-seat unit: 26"d x 32"h x 24" l
- 2-seat unit: 26"d x 32"h x 46" l
- 3-seat unit: 26"d x 32"h x 68" l
- Tablet arm: Adds 10" to length per arm
- Side Table: 24"d x 16"h x 24" w
- Top-opening receptacle: 26"d x 30"h x 26" w
- Side-opening receptacle: 26"d x 40"h x 26" w

Wood and Metal Finishes

Wood choices are pictured at right. Interior woods are finished with Landscape Forms' exclusive LF-80 wood finish, a clear, catalyzed lacquer. Custom stain may be specified for maple and red oak for an upcharge. Metal is finished with Landscape Forms' exclusive Pangard II® polyester powdercoat, a hard yet flexible finishing process that resists rusting, chipping, peeling and fading. Available in a variety of standard colors, Pangard II® powdercoat may be specified in a wide array of optional colors for an upcharge.

To Specify

Seating: Specify Washington Square one-, two-, or three-seat unit. Select perforated metal seat or wood type; specify interior or exterior use. Specify with or without tablet arm(s) and placement. Determine right or left placement of tablet arm(s) from the position of sitting in the seat. For two- or three-seat units, specify with or without intermediate arms. Select powdercoat color.

Side Table: Specify Washington Square side table. Select powdercoat color.

Litter Receptacle: Specify top- or side-opening. Specify optional ash urn and/or keyed lock for an upcharge. Select powdercoat color. If optional powdercoat is specified, select standard color for liner.

Mounting

Seats, side tables and receptacles feature a concealed surface mount option. The supplied nylon glides may be removed from the legs and secured to hard surfacing with appropriate anchors (supplied by installer). The legs then slide back onto the glides and a stainless steel set screw is engaged to secure each leg.
